The Building Societies (Authorised Banks) (No. 5) Order, 1961

The Deputy Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies, with the consent of the Treasury, pursuant to the powers conferred upon him by section 68 and subsection (7) of section 11 of the Building Societies Act, 1960, and to all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

1. The following bank is hereby designated so as to be authorised to hold funds of a building society for the purposes of section 11 of the Building Societies Act, 1960, that is to say—

Baring Brothers & Company, Limited.

2. In this Order "building society" means a society incorporated under the Building Societies Acts, 1874 to 1960, and any such unincorporated building society as is mentioned in section 7 of the Building Societies Act, 1874.

3. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Authorised Banks) (No. 5) Order, 1961.
