#### THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF OLDHAM

*The County Borough of Oldham No. 3 (Holts) Smoke Control Order, 1961*

1. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Oldham, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 23rd day of May 1961.
