

not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st May 1962, or before a later date determined under the provisions of the Clean Air Act, 1956.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Parliamentary Office (Room 115), Town Clerk's Department, Town Hall, Manchester, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 26th day of May 1961.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area to which the Order relates is within the City of Manchester and is bounded on the north by the City boundary and the River Mersey, on the east by the River Mersey, on the south by the railway line from Stockport to Altrincham and on the west by the City boundary but excludes an area of about 10.63 acres which is subject to the City of Manchester (Royle Green, Northenden) Smokeless Zone Order, 1956, and an area of about 2.78 acres which is subject to the City of Manchester (Boardley Walk, Baguley) Smokeless Zone Order, 1956; the smoke control area is about 2,183 acres in extent and is more particularly indicated on the map referred to in the Order.

COUNTY BOROUGH OF NORTHAMPTON

The Northampton Parking Place (Revocation) Order, 1961

On the 8th day of May 1961, the Northampton County Borough Council made an Order under section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, which Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of May 1961, the effect of which will be to revoke the Northampton Parking Place (Victoria Promenade) Order, 1958 whereby part of the North side of Victoria Promenade from a point 210 feet East of Swan Street for a distance 460 feet eastwards was authorised for use as a parking place.
