The Borough of Morley (No. 8) Smoke Control Order, 1961

An area of approximately 2½ acres and located on Ordnance Survey Sheet SE 2725, and bounded by a line commencing in the centre of Dewsbury Road, Tingley and continuing in a north westerly direction along the north easterly boundary of a miniature golf course plot No. 6073 to the centre of a railway track; thence in a north easterly direction along the centre of the said railway track; thence in a southeasterly direction along the south westerly boundary of a track; thence in a south westerly direction along the north westerly boundary of Thornfield; thence in a south easterly direction along the south westerly boundary of Thornfield; thence in north easterly direction along the south easterly boundary of Thornfield; thence in a south easterly direction along the south westerly boundary of a track to the centre of Dewsbury Road; thence in a south westerly direction along the centre of Dewsbury Road to the point of commencement.

An area of approximately 5½ acres and located on Ordnance Survey Sheet SE 2329, and bounded by a line commencing in the centre of Scott Green, Gildersome and continuing in a southerly direction along the westerly boundary of 6 Scott Green; thence in an easterly direction along the southerly boundary of the gardens of 6, 4A Scott Green and 2 Greenfield Avenue, Gildersome; thence in a southerly direction along the westerly boundary of the gardens of 10 to 30 Greenfield Avenue; thence in a westerly direction along the northerly boundary of plot No. 9234 and plot No. 7428; thence in a northerly direction across plot No. 7635, plot No. 7540, plot No. 7347; thence in an easterly direction along the southerly boundary of plot No. 7853 to the centre of Scott Green, Gildersome; thence in a south easterly direction veering east to the point of commencement.

PART 3

The Borough of Morley (No. 11) Smoke Control Order, 1961

An area of approximately 72 acres and located on Ordnance Survey Sheets SE 2630, SE 2730, SE 2629 and SE 2729, and bounded by a line commencing in the centre of Elland Road, Churwell at the Borough Boundary and continuing in a south westerly direction along the centre of Elland Road, Churwell; thence in a north westerly direction along the centre of School Street, Churwell; thence in a north easterly direction along the centre of Old Road, Churwell; thence in a north westerly direction veering westerly and continuing north westerly along the centre of a footpath and across open land to the centre of a cart track; thence in a northerly direction along the centre of a cart track passing under a railway track to the centre of Gelderd Road, Gildersome; thence in a north easterly direction along the centre of Gelderd Road, Gildersome; thence in an easterly direction following the tortuous municipal boundary between Morley Borough and the City of Leeds to the point of commencement in the centre of Elland Road, Churwell, but excluding the premises numbered 33 and 34-35 Low Fold, Churwell.

An area of approximately 3½ acres and located on Ordnance Survey Sheets SE2925 and SE 2926, and bounded by a line commencing in the centre of Common Lane, East Ardsley and continuing in a south westerly direction; thence in a westerly direction along the northerly boundary of 65 Common Lane, East

Ardsley; thence in a north westerly direction along the rear boundary fences of Nos. 16 to 26 The Grove; thence in a north easterly direction along the boundary wall of allotment gardens; thence in a south easterly direction along the rear boundary fence of Nos. 21 and 19 Casson Avenue; thence in a north easterly direction along the side boundary fence of No. 19 Casson Avenue; thence in a south easterly direction along the centre of Casson Avenue; thence in a south westerly direction along the side boundary fence of No. 13 Casson Avenue and the rear boundary fence of Nos. 4 to 10 Casson Grove; thence in a south easterly direction along the side boundary fence of Nos. 10 and 9 Casson Grove; thence in a north easterly direction along the rear boundary fence of Nos. 9 to 5 Casson Grove; thence in a south easterly direction along the side boundary fence of Ashlea, Common Lane to the point of commencement.

BOROUGH OF EALING

The Ealing (No. 1) Smoke Control (Arundell School—Amendment) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Ealing in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 16th day of May 1961, made an Order entitled "The Ealing (No. 1) Smoke Control (Arundell School—Amendment) Order," which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The Order provides that the boiler plant at Arundell School, Hartfield Avenue, Northolt, Middlesex, shall be exempted from the operation of section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on condition that no fuel shall be used other than that for which the mechanical stokers are designed and that the plant shall be maintained and operated so that the emission of smoke is kept to a minimum.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st March 1962, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order may be inspected, free of charge, at the Town Clerk's Offices at the Town Hall, Ealing, London W.5, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from 27th May 1961.

Within the said period, any persons who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

ROCHDALE COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Rochdale (Brotherod & Rooley Moor) Smoke Control Order, 1961

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Rochdale in pursuance of the provisions of section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 3rd day of May 1961 made an Order entitled the County Borough of Rochdale (Brotherod & Rooley Moor) Smoke Control Order, 1961, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1962 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.
