MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

On the 4th May 1961, the Minister of Transport confirmed the above-named Order made by the Mon-mouthshire County Council under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which is:

1. Save as provided in Article 2 hereof, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 3 tons on the length of road specified in the schedule hereto.

2. Nothing in Article 1 hereof, shall prevent the driving upon the length of road referred to in that Article of any vehicle which is being used:

(a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road;
(b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to that length of road or for

the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon

that land;

(c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.

Ethelbert Crescent: Both sides, from No. 27 Ethelbert Crescent to No. 1 Eastern Esplanade. (Amendment of time of existing Order operative 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.).

Order No. 4. Between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. from 15th May to 15th September: Wilderness Hill: East side, from its junction with Northdown Road to its junction with Clarendon Road.

Order No. 5. Between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.: Edgar Road: East side, from its junction with North-down Road to its junction with St. Paul's Road.

Order No. 6. Between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. 15th May to 15th September: Grosvenor Place: Both sides, for a length of 30 yards south of its junction with Marine Gardens.
