# The Trunk Road (New Road, Peterborough) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1961

On 23rd May 1961, the Minister of Transport made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic 1960, which came into operation on 1st June 1961.

The effect of the Order is that with certain exceptions no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 am. and 6.30 p.m.:

(a) in that length of the Birmingham—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A.47) in the City of Peterborough, known as New Road, which lies between its junction with Swan Place and a point 5 yards north-east of its south-western junction with Brook Street

(b) in that length of the said Trunk Road, known as New Road, which lies between a point 5 yards north-east of its south-western junction with Brook Street

(ii) on the south-western junction with Brook Street—

(iii) on the south-west side on even dates; or

(iii) on that side on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting by sub-paragraph (i) or (ii) of paragraph (b)—

(1) for a longer period than thirty minutes; or

(2) if a period of less than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side.
