

BOROUGH OF PRESTWICH

The Borough of Prestwich (Agecroft Road) Smoke Control Order, 1961

1. Notice is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Prestwich in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 24th day of May 1961, made an Order entitled "The Borough of Prestwich (Agecroft Road) No. 4 Smoke Control Order, 1961", declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Prestwich, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 16th day of June 1961.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area of land referred to comprises all properties within a total area of 85.5 acres divided into three sections: the first comprises an area of 79.7 acres the boundary of which commences in the East at a point 200 feet to the East of Hope Road at the centre of Hilton Lane and extends South-Westward along the centre of Hilton Lane to Butterstile Lane where it turns to follow the centre of Butterstile Lane in a Northerly direction to the boundary of Prestwich Hills Reservoirs. Here it turns in a Southerly direction along the Eastern boundary of reservoirs and then along the rear of the houses on the East side of Hope Road continuing along the side of "Rookwood" Hilton Lane to its point of commencement in Hilton Lane. The second section comprises an area of 0.42 acres the boundary of which surrounds the properties numbered 131-137 Bury New Road, starting at a point in the centre of the junction of Hilton Lane and Bury New Road and extending approximately 150 feet along the centre of Bury New Road and thence in a semi-circle running at the rear of the said properties to its point of commencement. The third section comprises an area of 5.42 acres the boundary of which commences in the South at a point in the centre of Bury New Road approximately 480 feet from Butterstile Lane, and extends Northwards to Butterstile Lane where it turns West along the centre of Butterstile Lane for a distance of approximately 450 feet, at which point it turns South for a distance of approximately 490 feet and then East and joins its point of commencement in Bury New Road, following the Southern boundary of No. 151 Bury New Road.

Subject to the exemption provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st October 1962, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at Southgate Town Hall, Green Lanes, Palmers Green, London N.13, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 9th day of June 1961.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
