SOUTHGATE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Southgate (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1961

1. Subject to the exemption provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st October 1962, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local

Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at Southgate Town Hall, Green Lanes, Palmers Green, London N.13, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 9th day of June 1961.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
