EAST CORNWALL WATER BOARD

Notice is hereby given that the East Cornwall Water Board (hereinafter called "the Board") are about to make application to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for an Order (hereinafter called "the Order") under section 1 of the Water Act, 1958, the general effect of which is to amend section 38 (Restriction on taking water) of the South East Cornwall Water Board Act, 1936 (hereinafter called "the Act of 1936"), so as to permit the Board for a period of six months from the coming into operation of the Order:

- (1) to abstract water from the Rushyford Brook by means of the intake Work No. 1 authorised by the Act of 1936 when the rate of flow in that brook immediately below that work amounts to a rate of not less than fifty thousand gallons in twenty-four hours;
- (2) to abstract water from the Withey Brook by means of the intake Work No. 2 authorised by the Act of 1936 when the rate of flow in that brook immediately below that work amounts to a rate of not less than fifty thousand gallons in twenty-four hours;
- (3) to abstract water from the said brooks by means of the said works when the rate of flow below the said works amounts together to a rate of not less than 300,000 gallons in twenty-four hours.

Any person desiring to bring before the Minister of Housing and Local Government any objection to the application for the Order may do so by notice addressed to the Secretary, (Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, and despatched within seven days of the date of this notice and any person so objecting is requested to send a copy of his notice of objection to the undersigned.

The County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Kesteven (Roads Restriction) (Twenty Foot Road, Billingham Dales) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1961

The County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Kesteven have applied to the Ministry of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to restrict the use of that length of the Twenty Foot Road, Billingham Dales (C.57) between points 1160 yards and 1210 yards from its junction with the Sleaford—Tattershall Road (A.153) to vehicles of not more than 2 tons gross weight for
