###### CORNWALL RIVER BOARD *New Fishery Byelaws*

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall River Board intend to apply at the expiration of one calendar month from the date of the publication of this notice for the confirmation by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, of Byelaws made by the Board for securing the efficient discharge of their functions.

The proposed Byelaws, which relate to the Tamar and Plym Fishery District only, extend (a) the Annual Close Season for Salmon (rod and line) and (b) the Weekly Close Time for Salmon and Trout from forty-eight hours to seventy-two hours during the months of March, April and May.

During a period of one calendar month from the date of publication of this notice, a printed copy of the said Byelaws will be deposited at the offices of the Board (as under) and will be open to public inspection, without charge, on any weekday during the usual office hours. During the same period
