

*Highways Act, 1959**The Darlington By-Pass, Barton By-Pass and Darlington Spur Special Roads (North Riding of York) (Improvements) Order, 1961*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 13 and 18 of the above Act, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to provide for the re-alignment and regrading of thirteen lengths of existing roads, footpaths and bridleways which will be affected by the construction of the Darlington By-Pass, Barton By-Pass, and Darlington Spur Special Roads;
- (b) to provide for the construction by the Minister of new highways consisting of twelve new roads and eight new footpaths and bridleways for purposes connected with the construction of the said special roads, in substitution for lengths of existing roads, footpaths and bridleways authorised by the Order to be stopped up;
- (c) to provide for the stopping up by the Minister of lengths of existing side roads, footpaths and bridleways which cross or enter the routes of, or will be affected by the construction of, the said special roads;
- (d) to provide for the construction of one new means of access to premises adjoining or adjacent to land comprised in the route of the Darlington Spur Special Road;
- (e) that the County Council of York, North Riding will become the highway authority for the new highways on 1st April next after the day on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that any highway is opened for through traffic.

*Highways Act, 1959**Stratford St. Mary By-Pass Improvements*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 9 of the above Act providing—

- (a) for the construction by the Minister of four new roads at Dedham in the County of Essex, and four new roads at Stratford St. Mary in the County of East Suffolk, in substitution for roads to be stopped up under the Order or for purposes connected with the London-Great Yarmouth Trunk Road;
- (b) authority for the stopping up of six parts of roads that cross or enter the route of the By-Pass three roads and one footpath that enter the said Trunk Road and two parts of the said Trunk Road east of School Road;
- (c) that the County Councils of Essex and East Suffolk shall become the highway authorities for such of the new roads referred to in paragraph (a) of this notice, as are within their respective jurisdictions, on the dates on which notices are given by the Minister to those Councils that such new roads are opened for the purposes of through traffic.
