NEW TOWNS ACT, 1946

HEMEL HEMPSTEAD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

Hemel Hempstead Development Corporation (No. 26) High Street Area Compulsory Purchase Order, 1961.

Notice is hereby given that the Hemel Hempstead Development Corporation in pursuance of their powers under section 4 of the New Towns Act, 1946, on the 2nd day of November 1961, made an Order which has been submitted for confirmation by the Minister of Housing and Local Government authorising them to purchase compulsorily for the purposes of the New Town of Hemel Hempstead the lands described in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order, and of the map referred to therein, have been deposited at the Town Hall, Hemel Hempstead, and will be open for inspection without payment of fee between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing, stating the grounds of the objection and addressed to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 31st day of December 1961.

The Minister is not, in all cases, required to arrange for objections to be heard by a person appointed by him for that purpose. It is important, therefore, that an objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.

Any owner or occupier of any land to which the Order relates may send to the Hemel Hempstead

Development Corporation at the address below, a request in writing to serve him with a notice that the Order has been confirmed and naming a place where a copy of the Order and of the map and of any descriptive matter annexed thereto, may be seen. Such request should contain a statement of the name, postal address and the interest in the land of the owner or occupier, and particulars sufficient to enable the extent and boundaries of the land to be identified.
