assembled from cooks, mess staff and storemen, Lieutenant (Matthew who had already proved his courage in action a few days earlier, was given the task of capturing the feature. When fired upon he task of capturing the feature. When fired upon he deployed his men with skill and courage and over-ran two machine gun posts. The Platoon then came under the fire of the main hostile position on the other side of a small valley. Further advance was impossible. Lieutenant Matthew deployed his men in cover and returned the fire. Although seriously ununded and every form form form for her deployed by seriously wounded and suffering from loss of blood he con-tinued to encourage his men and control their fire. The firing lasted two and a half hours during which heavy casualcies were inflicted. At 4 p.m. the Congolese asked for a ceasefire and agreed to release the United Nistions the United Nations personnel from the prison. Lieutenant Matthew, by his tenacity and courage whilst suffering great pain, set an example to his men that proved decisive in the success of the operation.

On the lifth January, 1961, "D" Company, 4th Battalion, The Queen's Own Nigenia Regiment seized the airstrip at Manono. Sergeant Jibrin Gulani was Platoon Sergeant to No. 10 Platoon of "D" Company, occupying a position covering one of the approaches. At approximately 2 p.m. the platoon came under very heavy rifle and automatic fire from a unit which had infiltrated close to its position through the surrounding scrub. Throughout the a unit which had innitrated close to its position through the surrounding scrub. Throughout the action, which lasted for nearly an hour, Sergeant Jibrin Gulani remained in an exposed position en-couraging his men and controlling their fire. He gave no thought to his personal safety and set an example of courage and of leadership which was an inspiration to his men.
