

BREDBURY AND ROMILEY URBAN DISTRICT
COUNCILNOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
*The Bredbury and Romiley Urban District Council
Public Path Diversion Order, 1961*

On the 19th day of December 1961, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect is to divert the public right of way running from Ashton Road, Bredbury, at a point 335 yards north of its junction with Lingard Lane, in a westerly direction to the boundary of the Urban District of Bredbury and Romiley, to a line running from Ashton Road aforesaid, at a point 370 yards north of the said junction, in a westerly and west-south-westerly direction to the boundary of the said urban district. The old path will be closed on the 7th day of February 1962.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Bredbury, in the county of Chester, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. from Monday to Friday inclusive.

The Order becomes operative as from the 2nd day of January 1962, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.

*The Grimsby County Borough Council (Grantham
Avenue) Public Path Diversion Order, 1961*

On the 19th day of December 1961, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect is to divert the public right of way running across the playing field of the Scartho Primary Junior School to a line running 10 feet from the south-eastern and the south-western boundaries of that field (O.S. Parcel Number 309, Lincolnshire Sheet XXII-15, 1933 Edition). The existing right of way will be extinguished on and from the 17th day of January 1962.

PUDSEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

*The Borough of Pudsey Bradford Road—Woodhall
Lane Public Path Diversion Order, 1961*

On the 19th day of December 1961, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed with modifications the above Order.

Its effect is to divert the public right of way between Bradford Road and Woodhall, being a part which commences at a point approximately 135 yards north of Bradford Road and proceeds in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 253 yards at a width of 6 feet across field O.S. 61 to a point at the north-western corner of such field, to a new public right of way between Bradford Road and Woodhall which commences at a point approximately 135 yards north of Bradford Road and proceeds in a south-westerly direction for approximately 183 yards at a width of 6 feet to a point in the south-west corner of field O.S. 61 and thence in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 242 yards at a width of 6 feet to a point in the north-westerly corner of field O.S. No. 61.

The old public right of way will be closed for use by the general public on the 2nd January 1962, which is a period of fourteen days from the date of confirmation of the Order.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Pudsey, between 9 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturday.
