PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

BOROUGH OF ERITH.

The Borough of Erith (No. 1) Smoke Control Order, 1961

1. Notice is hereby given that the Erith Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 22nd day of November 1961, made an Order entitled the Borough of Erith (No. 1) Smoke Control Order, 1961, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 111 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding \$10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel.
