The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act, 1958, viz.: The Import Duties (General) (No. 2) Order, 1962.

This Order reduces, as from 1st March 1962, the rates of import duty on the goods to which the European Free Trade Association Convention applies. The reduction is of one-seventh of the existing E.F.T.A. rates of duty except in the cases of (a) goods classified in the subheadings shown in Schedule 1 to the Order, which are to be charged at particular rates of duty, and (b) pectin and certain animal oils, which hitherto have not been subject to E.F.T.A. reductions, for which the reduction is of two-fifths of the existing rates.

The Order comes into operation on the 1st March 1962, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1962, No. 232.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act, 1958, viz.: The Import Duties (General) (No. 3) Order, 1962.

This Order increases the import duty chargeable on lettuce and endive during the period 1st March to 30th April.
