*Town and Country Planning Act, 1947**Land Powers (Defence) Act, 1958**R.A.F. Station, Fylingdales, Yorks.*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, as extended by section 8 of the Land Powers (Defence) Act, 1948, authorising the stopping up of a length of the bridleway known as Robin Hood's Bay Road at R.A.F.
