The said Works will include all the necessary subsidiary or ancillary works.

The estimated average daily yield of water of the said Works and of the Haweswater Undertaking when the said Works shall have been completed is respectively 10,000,000 gallons and 65,000,000 gallons.

SCHEDULE

(a) Substituted Work No. 5 comprising a reservoir (to be called "The Wet Sleddale Reservoir") to be situate in the Parish of Shap Rural in the Rural District of North Westmorland and to be formed by means of a dam across the River Lowther.

(b) The completion of Substituted Work No. 7a comprising a catchwater aqueduct conduit or line or lines of pipes to be situate in the Parish of Shap Rural commencing in the Wet Sleddale Reservoir and terminating at or near the Swindale Beck by a junction with that part of the Work (formerly Work No. 7) already constructed.

(c) Substituted Work No. 7b comprising an intake catchwater aqueduct conduit or line or lines of pipes commencing in the stream flowing from the northern slopes of Low Fell in the Parish of Shap Rural and terminating in the Wet Sleddale Reservoir.

(d) Substituted Work No. 7c comprising an intake catchwater aqueduct conduit or line or lines of pipes to be situate in the Parish of Shap Rural commencing in Thornship Gill and terminating by a junction with Substituted Work No. 7a.

(e) A further instalment of Work No. 16 comprising, *inter alia*, the construction of parts of the third line of pipes of the Haweswater Aqueduct between Haweswater and the Woodgate Hill Reservoir, Bury.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

ACTION BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Acton Smoke Control Order No. 5, 1962

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Acton, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 6th day of November 1961, made an Order entitled the Borough of Acton Smoke Control Order No. 5, 1962, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 111 (4) of the Clean Air Act, 1956, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of December 1962, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Acton, London W.3, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 16th day of May 1962.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

Land and premises in the borough of Acton comprised in an area bounded on the north side by High Street between its junction with Crown Street
