The Borough of Scarborough (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

On the 5th July 1962, the Scarborough Borough Council made an order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the schedule hereto on such days and during such hours as are specified in the second and third columns respectively of the schedule.

Exceptions are provided to enable a vehicle to wait on any of the lengths of road for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, for goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from it, or for it to be used in connection with any funeral, any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or the doing of work to the lengths of road or the services therein.

The order comes into operation on the 14th July 1962.

12. Both sides of <i>Londesborough Road</i> between its junction with Falsgrave Road and its junction with Westover Road.	All days	All hours

21. South side of <i>Valley Road</i> between its junction with Ramshill Road and a point 275 yards to the west of such junction.
