The County Borough of Warrington (Bewsey Street and Wilson Patten Street) Waiting Restrictions Order, 1962.

The Warrington County Borough Council on the 26th day of June 1962, made an Order under sections 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit from the 1st day of August 1962, the waiting of vehicles in the following lengths of streets:

Bewsey Street—From its junction with Winwick Street to a point 30 feet north west of Brown Street.

Wilson Patten Street—South side from a point 245 feet east of its junction with Slutchers Lane to a point 395 feet east of the junction.
