SALOP COUNTY COUNCIL

The Salop County Council (High Street, Wem) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

On the 12th July 1962, the Salop County Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles from waiting in the length of High Street, Wem (Route B.5063) between its junction with The Grove Housing Estate Road and the west end of the Church Hall.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from such vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from such vehicle, to enable such vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to enable such vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage on or adjacent to the said length of road.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of the Isle of Wight (Fairway, Sandown to Lower Adgestone Road) (Restriction) Order, 1962.

On the 9th day of July 1962, the Minister of Transport confirmed the above Order made by the Isle of Wight County Council under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle exceeding three tons in weight or which has seats for more than 20 persons, exclusive of the driver, along the road from the Fairway, Sandown to Lower Adgestone, subject to the usual exemptions.

Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit at Langtoft

Notice is hereby given that the Kesteven County Council intend to make application to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making of an Order, the effect of which will be that the following length of road shall be deemed to be a road in a built up area for the purposes of the Act:

Parish of Langtoft—That length of East End (Class III) which extends between a point 190 yards east of its junction with the Sleaford—Market Deeping Road (A.15) to its junction with New Road, a distance of 316 yards.

Any objection to the making of such Order should be sent to the Clerk of the Council not later than the 3rd September 1962.

CARDIFF CITY COUNCIL

The City and County Borough of Cardiff (Albany Road) (Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1962

The Cardiff City Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in Albany Road between its junction with Cottrell Road and Wellfield Road and a point 200 feet east of its junction with City Road and Mackintosh Place:

- (a) on the north side thereof on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays; or
- (b) on the south side thereof on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays; or
- (c) for a longer period than thirty minutes or until thirty minutes have elapsed since the last period of permitted waiting on that side of the said length of road where vehicles are not prohibited from waiting on that day.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable vehicles owned by a funeral director to be used in connection with any funeral cortege, etc., to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map indicating the proposal may be inspected by any person free of charge during normal office hours at the address given below.
