PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Ministry of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted to Steef Brothers and Company Limited, Chesterfield House, 26-28 Fenchurch Street, London E.C.3, Continental Oil Limited, Moor House, London Wall, London E.C.2, Marathon Petroleum (G.B.) Limited, 18 Austin Friars, London E.C.2, and Envoy Oil Limited, 18 Austin Friars, London E.C.2, in association, sixteen prospecting licences, details of which are given in the Schedule below. The boundaries are described from the 2½" Ordnance Survey Map.

Maps showing boundaries of the areas may be inspected on application to the Ministry of Power, Petroleum Division, Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1.

SCHEDULE

An Area of approximately 178 square miles in the Counties of Westmorland and York.

Northern Boundary

From Summit Cottages on the A.66, six miles east of Brough, the boundary follows the A.66 eastwards through Bowes to the crossroads just before the milestone 3½ miles from Bowes.

Eastern Boundary

From the crossroads on the A.66, the boundary follows the road southwards across Scargill High Moor and Hope Moor, through Langthwaite to Reeth.

Southern Boundary

From Reeth the boundary follows the B.6270 westwards through Healough and Feetham to Long Row, thence through Crackpot and Summer Lodge to Askrigg Station and along the railway line to Hawes. From Hawes the boundary follows the A.684 through Appersett to the road junction by the Moorcock Inn near Garsdale Head.

Western Boundary

From the Moorcock Inn the boundary follows the B.6259 northwards through Aisgill, Outhgill, Castlethwaite and Southwaite to Stenkrith Bridge near the station at Kirkby Stephen. Thence it follows the railway line through Barras to the road bridge at Clatteringdike and along the road about half a mile to Summit Cottages on the A.66.

An Area of approximately 191 square miles in the County of York.

Northern Boundary

From the milestone 3½ miles east of Bowes on the A.66 the boundary follows the A.66 eastwards through Greta Bridge to Scotch Corner.

Eastern Boundary

From Scotch Corner, the boundary follows the A.1 southwards through Catterick to the railway station at Leeming Bar.

Southern Boundary

From Leeming Bar, the boundary follows the railway line eastwards through Bedale and Leyburn to the station at Askrigg.

Western Boundary

From Askrigg the boundary follows the road northwards through Summer Lodge, Crackpot, Long Row, Feetham and Healough to Reeth, thence through Arkle Town and Langthwaite and across Hope Moor and Scargill High Moor to the junction with the A.66.

An Area of approximately 179 square miles in the County of York.

Northern Boundary

Commencing at the railway bridge over the A.684 near Hawes, the boundary follows the railway line eastwards through Askrigg to the bridge over the road beyond Bear Park near Aysgarth.

Eastern Boundary

From Aysgarth, the boundary follows the road southwards through Thoraby, Kidstones, Buckden, Kettlewell and Kainsey to the railway line at Threshfield, thence along the railway line to the railway station at Hetton.

Southern Boundary

From Hetton the boundary follows the road westwards through Winterburn to Airton, thence northwards through Kirkby Malham and Malham and along the road across the moors to the west of Malham Tarn to Langcliffe.

Western Boundary

From Langcliffe the boundary follows the railway line northwards through Horton in Ribblesdale to Ribbleshead Station, thence along the B.6255 across Gayle Moor and Redshaw Moss to Hawes.

An Area of approximately 196 square miles in the County of York.

Northern Boundary

From Aysgarth, the boundary follows the railway line eastwards to Leyburn.

Eastern Boundary

From Leyburn the boundary follows the A.6108 in a south-easterly direction through Middleham and East Witton to Jervaulx Abbey, thence southwards through Billingspring, Healey and Ilton to Swetton Bridge on Kirkby Malzeard Moor. The boundary then follows the road westwards through Swetton, across Swetton Moor and Fountains Earth Moor, through Bouthwaite to Ramsgill, thence southwards to Bridgehouse Gate at Pateley Bridge.

Southern Boundary

From Pateley Bridge the boundary follows the B.6265 through Greenhow Hill, Hebden and Grassington to Threshfield.

Western Boundary

From Threshfield the boundary follows the road northwards through Kainsey, Kettlewell, Buckden, Kidstones and Thoraby to the railway line at Aysgarth.
