## DUDLEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The County Borough of Dudley Old Park No. 5  
Smoke Control Order, 1962*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Dudley in the County of Worcester in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 18th day of July 1962, made an Order entitled *The County Borough of Dudley Old Park No. 5 Smoke Control Order, 1962*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 of the Act if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity; and fireplaces burning liquid fuels are exempted from the provisions of section 11, on certain conditions by virtue of the *Smoke Control Areas (Exempted Fireplaces) Order, 1957*.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 30th day of September 1963 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

A copy of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge, at the Council House, Dudley, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 28th day of July 1962.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

## SCHEDULE

The area, being land situate within the County Borough of Dudley bounded by the Westerly side of Wrens Nest Road at its junction with Old Park Road to the borough boundary in Parkes Hall Road and thence proceeding in a Westerly direction along the borough boundary from Parkes Hall Road to Eve Lane to the junction with Burton Road; thence in a South-Easterly direction along the Burton Road boundary of the borough to its junction with Old Park Road and thence along the Southerly side of Old Park Road to its junction with Wrens Nest Road.
