Description of Area

The boundary starts at a point at the centre of the junction between Leverstock Green Road and Green Lane and proceeds along Green Lane in a north-easterly direction to the borough boundary. Turning north, it traverses the boundary to its junction with the centre of Breakspear Way. Here it turns in a south-westerly direction and follows the centre of Breakspear Way until it reaches the centre of the roundabout at the junction with Maylands Avenue and Leverstock Green Way. It then turns in a southerly direction and proceeds along the centre of Leverstock Green Way and Leverstock Green Road to the starting point.
