The Trunk Road (Leicester Road, Nuneaton) (One Way Traffic) Order, 1962

On the 17th July 1962, the Minister of Transport made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, which will come into operation on the 3rd August 1962.

The effect of the Order is that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on that length of the Birmingham—Great Yarmouth Trunk Road (A.47) in the Borough of Nuneaton, known as Leicester Road, which lies between its junction with Old Hinckley Road and its junction with Weddington Road otherwise than in the direction from north-east to south-west.

The London Traffic (Prohibition of Cycling on Footpaths City of St. Albans) Regulations, 1962 (S.I. 1962/1534)

The London Traffic (Prohibition of Waiting) (Walton and Weybridge) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1962 (S.I. 1962/1535)

Under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, as amended, the Minister of Transport has made Regulations, coming into operation on 8th August 1962, which prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in Queens Road, Hersham, between its junction with Molesey Road and its junction with Westcar Lane and West Grove.
