*Waiting Restrictions and Parking Places on the Highway
County of Kent*

The Minister of Transport proposes to make Regulations under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, as amended:

1. to restrict waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Saturdays, in Station Road, Longfield, as follows:

(a) the west side, from Main Road to a point 57 yards south of Kent Road (junction with southern arm);

(b) the east side, from a point 44 yards south of Kent Road to its junction with the southern arm and including the first 10 yards of the north side of the southern arm.

2. to appoint street parking places between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. as follows:

(a) Essex Road, Longfield, south side, from a point 10 yards west of Station Road westwards for a distance of 120 yards;

(b) Kent Road, Longfield, north side, from a point 10 yards west of Station Road westwards for a distance of 115 yards.

Exemptions would be provided in the Regulations in respect of 1 (a) and (b) above to permit vehicles to wait in order to pick up and set down passengers, to load and unload goods, to carry out essential services, or while in use by local authorities in an emergency.

The parking places would be available for use by vehicles of any description, other than locomotives or vehicles carrying Trade Licence plates.

RIVER BOARDS ACT, 1948

Great Ouse River Board

Middle Fen Internal Drainage District
