The Borough of Weston-super-Mare (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

The Borough Council of Weston-super-Mare propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the following lengths of street between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.:

- (a) The Boulevard—north side for a distance of 15 yards east from its junction with Longton Grove Road.
- (b) Longton Grove Road—east and west sides for a distance of 15 yards north from its junction with The Boulevard.
- (c) Waterloo Street—north side for a distance of 15 yards west of its junction with Longton Grove Road.

The Borough of Weston-super-Mare (Waterloo Street) (Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1962

The Borough Council of Weston-super-Mare propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to introduce limited waiting on the following lengths of road between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.:

- (a) Waterloo Street—North side from a point 38 yards east of its junction with High Street to a point 15 yards west of its junction with Longton Grove Road.
- (b) Waterloo Street—South side from a point 38 yards east of its junction with High Street to its junction with the Boulevard.

WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Un-named Road at Stone) (Restrictions on Driving) Order, 1962.

On the 29th August 1962, the Minister of Transport confirmed the above-named Order made by the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the driving of any vehicle (other than a handcart, perambulator, invalid carriage or pedal cycle) on the length of the un-named road at Stone, in the Urban District of Maltby, between its junction with the Rotherham and Barnby Moor County Road (A.634) at a point approximately 70 yards north west of the school and its junction with the said County Road immediately west of Stone Grange.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable any vehicle to be used (a) for the conveyance of goods, persons or merchandise to or from any adjoining premises (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with adjoining land or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land, or (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of services therein.

GLOUCESTER COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The City of Gloucester (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order, 1961
