## ALFRETON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL The Alfreton (Various Streets) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 11962

On the 4th day of September 1962 the Alfreton Urban District Council made an Order under section (26) (27) of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of Which will be to restrict as from the list day of October 1962, the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in certain streets in Alfreton described in the Schedules to the Order, particulars of which are given below:

Schedule 1. Unilateral waiting-limited to 30 minutes in any one hour

High Street, Alfreton. (A.615) (North Side) Between a point 77 yards east of its junction with King Street (A.61) and its junction with Rodger's Lane.

- High Street, Alfreton. (A.615) (South Side) (a) Between a point 77 yards east of its junction with King Street (A.61) and its junction with Institute Lane.
  - (b) Between its junction with Chapel Street, and its junction with Cressy Road.

Institute Lane, Alfreton Between a point 40 yards south of its junction with High Street and its junction with the north side of the Omnibus Station.

Schedule 2. Waiting limited to 30 minutes in any one hour

High Street, Alfreton (South Side) Between a point 24 yards east of its junction with the east side of Cressy Road, and its junction with George Street.

Schedule 3. No waiting permitted in the following streets or parts of Streets

- (a) Church Street, Alfreton (North Side) -Between its junction with Chesterfie'd Road, and a point 24 yards west of that junction.
- (b) Cressy Road, Alfreton-Between its junction with High Street and a point 40 yards south of that junction.
- (c) Hall Street, Alfreton (North Side)-Between its junction with King Street and a point 15 yards east of that junction.
- (d) Hall Street, Alfreton (South Side)--Between its junction with King Street and a point 40 yards east of that junction.
- (e) High Street, Alfreton-Between its junction with King Street and a point 77 yards east of that junction.
- (f) High Street, Alfreton (North Side)-Between its junction with Rodger's Lane and its junction with Mansfield Road.
- (g) High Street, Alfreton (South Side)—Between its junction with Institute Lane and a point 16 yards east of that junction and between its junction with Chapel Street and a point 13 yards west of that junction.
- (h) Institute Lane, Alfreton-Between its junction with High Street and a point 40 yards south of that junction and between its junction with Hall Street and a point 93 yards north of that junction.
- (i) Limes Avenue, Alfreton-Between its junction with High Street and a point 40 yards north of that junction.
- (j) Mansfield Road, Alfreton-Between its junction with High Street and a point 172 yards north east of that junction.
- (k) Nottingham Road, Alfreton-Between its junc-tion with George Street and its junction with Wycliffe Road.
- (I) Road west side of Old Market Place, Alfreton— Between its junction with Church Street and a point 47 yards south of that junction.
- (n) Wycliffe Road, Alfreton-Between its junction with High Street and a point 97 yards north of that junction.
- (n) Wycliffe Road, Alfreton—Between its junction with Nottingham Road and a point 40 yards south of that junction on the west side and a point 115 yards south of that junction on the east side.

The Order is subject to certain exceptions relating to:

(1) Waiting necessary to enable

(a) boarding or alighting from a vehicle;

 (b) loading or unloading goods;
(c) building operations, demolitions, removal of obstructions to traffic and maintenance of the length of noad or services therein; and

(2) Vehicles owned by funeral directors or owners of funeral vehicles when in use in connection with a funeral.

On the western side of Hill Lane from the junc-tion with Howard Road for a distance northwards of 180 feet and for a distance southwards of 520 feet.

On the northern side of Howard Road from the 145 feet.

On the southern side of Howard Road from the unction with Hill Lane for a distance westwards of 145 feet.

On the northern side of Archers Road from the junction with Hill Lane for a distance eastwards of 155 feet.

On the southern side of Archers Road from the unction with Hill Lane for a distance eastwards of 160 feet.
