

## NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*Proposed Alteration of Speed Limit on Roads North of Hucknall*

Road Traffic Act, 1960—Sections 20 and 21.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Administrative County of Nottingham intend to make application to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making of an Order the effect of which will be that the lengths of road specified in the Schedule hereunder shall be deemed to be roads in a built-up area for the purposes of the Act.

Any objection to the making of such Order should be sent to the Clerk of the County Council, County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham, not later than the 12th day of October 1962.

## SCHEDULE

## 1. Nottingham—Hucknall—Mansfield Road—Route A.611.

The extension of the 30 m.p.h. speed limit on the Nottingham—Hucknall—Mansfield Road (Route A.611) from a point 37 yards south of the junction of the Linby—Papplewick Road (Route B.6011) to a point 187 yards in a northerly direction.

## 2. Linby—Papplewick Road—Route B.6011

The imposition of a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on the Linby—Papplewick Road (Route B.6011)—Wighay Lane from its junction with the Nottingham—Hucknall—Mansfield Road (Route A.611) for a length of 873 yards in an easterly direction and terminating on the east side of railway bridge No. 22 passing over the Leen Valley Railway line.
