## CHADDERTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The Chadderton (No. 5 Area) Smoke Control Order, 1962*

1. Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Chadderton in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, on the 10th day of July 1962, made an Order entitled the Chadderton (No. 5 Area) Smoke Control Order, 1962, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed, the Order will not come into operation before 1st April 1964, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Middleton Road, Chadderton, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 6th day of October 1962.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
