Proposed Bus Service—Bargued to Merthyr Tydfil

Notice is hereby given that the Gelligaer Urban District Council have applied to the Traffic Commissioners for the South Wales Traffic Area for consent under sections 101 and 102 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to the running by the Council of motor omnibuses from the boundary of the urban district north of Fochriw via the Class 3 road to its junction with trunk road A.465, thence via A.465 to Pontmorlais, Merthyr Tydfil, and A.470 to Merthyr Station.

BRISTOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The City and County of Bristol (Traffic Regulation)
(No. 2) Order, 1962*

On the 19th September 1962 the Bristol County Borough Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, which will come into operation on the 1st December 1962, and the effect of which is with certain exceptions:

(a) to prevent any vehicle waiting on the under-mentioned lengths of road:

Bell Hill, Stapleton. B4058 North side—from east side of Bell Hotel to a point 200 ft. west.

Whiteladies Road. A4018 East side—from Lower Redland Road to a point 80 ft. north of Lower Redland Road.

(b) to prevent any vehicle waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Mondays to Saturdays (inclusive) on the undermentioned lengths of road:

St. Michael's Hill. North-east side—from Upper Maudlin Street to Robin Hood Lane.

Horfield Road. West side—from St. Michael's Hill to a point opposite the north side of Bedford Place and from a point opposite the south side of Prospect Avenue to Alfred Hill. East side—from St. Michael's Hill to the south side of 20 Horfield Road and from the south side of Terrell Street to Alfred Hill.

Easton Road. B4465 From Clarence Road to The Paddock.

St. Luke's Road. East side—from York Road to Mead Street. West side—from York Road to a point 360 ft. south of York Road.

Lombard Street. North-east side—from East Street to a point 50 ft. north-west of East Street. South-west side—from East Street to St. John's Square.

Cannon Street. B3120 West side—from 13 Cannon Street to North Street.

North Street. B3120 South side—from Cannon Street to 9 North Street.

Ashton Avenue. B3122 South side—from Avon Crescent for 320 ft. in a westerly direction.

The Mall. West side—from Gloucester Row to Portland Street.

Bath Street. North side—from Bristol Bridge to Counterslip.

Cheapside Street. North side—from Wells Road to Oxford Street. South side—from Wells Road to Steven's Crescent.

Steven's Crescent. South-east side—from Cheapside Street to 3 Steven's Crescent.

Oxford Street. West side—from Bush Street to Cheapside Street.

Angers Road. North side—from Wells Road to Bath Road. South side—from Wells Road to a point 130 ft. east of Wells Road and from Bath Road to a point 160 ft. west of Bath Road.

Bath Road. A4 South side—from entrance of Arno's Vale Crematorium to a point opposite Sandy Park Road.

Redcatch Road. B3122 North side—from Wells Road to Queensdale Road. South side—from Wells Road to a point 60 ft. west of Wells Road.

Grove Road. North-west side—from Whiteladies Road to St. Vincents Hill (North).

Lower Redland Road. South side—from Whiteladies Road to a point 150 ft. east of Whiteladies Road.

Henleaze Road. B4056 West side—from Waterford Road to a point 250 ft. north of Antrim Road. East side—from Holmes Grove to a point 100 ft. North of Holmes Grove, and from Henley Grove to The Drive.

Canford Lane. North side—from Falcondale Road to High Street.

High Street, Westbury-on-Trym. B4055 West side—from Canford Lane to pedestrian crossing. South side—from Westbury Hill to Stoke Lane. East side—from pedestrian crossing to Westbury Hill.

Westbury Hill. B4055 South-west side—from High Street to the north side of 73 Westbury Hill. North-east side—from High Street to Water's Lane and including Methodist Church.
