#### RATES OF INTEREST ON LOCAL LOANS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Public Works Loans Act, 1897 (60 & 61 Vict. c. 51), the Public Works Loans Act, 1935 (26 Geo. 5 & 1 Edw. 8. c. 5), and the Local Authorities Loans Act, 1945 (8 & 9 Geo. 6. c. 18), they have directed by their Minute of 3rd October 1962, that on loans advanced to local authorities from the Local Loans Fund, on and after the 6th October 1962, there shall be chargeable in lieu of the rates fixed by the Treasury Minute of

the 13th September 1962, the following rates of interest:

Loans for more than 5 years but not more than 15 years ...	6½
Loans for more than 15 years but not more than 30 years ...	6¾
