Other Companies Winding-Up Notices at the rates given under (f).

  (c) Friendly Societies Notices: 7s. 6d.

  (d) Notices under the Trustee Act, 1925 (Executor and Administrator) in columnar form: 15s. Other Notices under the Act at rates given under (f).

  (e) Deputy Lieutenants Commissions: 10s. for each Commission.
