PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted to Coastal Oil Company Limited, 53 New Broad Street, London E.C.2, six prospecting licences covering areas of which exact details are given in the Schedule below.

An area of approximately 31 square miles

All that part of the foreshore in the County of York and of the seabed adjacent thereto which is bounded to the west by High Water Mark of Ordinary Tides, to the north by a straight line drawn from the point TIA 1960-5140 (at Atwick Sands) through the point TIA 2200-5277 as far as the limits of British territorial waters, to the east by the limits of British territorial waters and to the south by a line drawn from the point TIA 2588-3965 (near Aldbrough Coast Guard Station) to the point TIA 2700-4000 and thence by a straight line through the point TIA 3000-4094 as far as the limits of British territorial waters, all the said points being located by reference to the National Grid.

An area of approximately 28 square miles

All that part of the foreshore in the County of York and of the seabed adjacent thereto which is bounded to the west by the High Water Mark of Ordinary Tides, to the north by a straight line drawn from the point TIA 0590-8619 (on or near Frank Cliff) through the point TIA 0900-8821 as far as the limits of British territorial waters, to the east by the limits of British territorial waters and to the south by a straight line drawn from the point TIA 1315-7730 (at West Nab) through the point TIA 1700-8138 as far as the limits of British territorial waters, all the said points being located by reference to the National Grid.

An area of approximately 33 square miles

All that part of the foreshore in the County of York and the seabed adjacent thereto which is bounded to the west by the High Water Mark of Ordinary Tides, to the north by a straight line drawn from the point TIA 0020-9970 (on Beast Cliff) through the point ONV 0346-0155 as far as the limits of British territorial waters, to the east by the limits of British territorial waters and to the south by a straight line drawn from the point TIA 0590-8619 (on or near Frank Cliff) through the point TIA 0900-8821 as far as the limits of British territorial waters, all the said points being located by reference to the National Grid.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Chester) (No. 15) Order 1962," authorising the stopping up of lengths of two footpaths between Vernon Road, Highfield Cemetery and Highfield Lane at Bredbury and Romiley, Cheshire, and requiring the provision of three new footpaths and three other new highways.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of 9th November 1962, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
