RIVER BOARDS ACT, 1948

Lincolnshire River Board

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, as applied by the River Boards Act, 1948, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Lincolnshire River Board for the transfer to the River Board of all such rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities (including liabilities incurred in connection with works) over or in connection with the main river of the River Board Area as were immediately before the date of submission of the Scheme vested in or to be discharged by various drainage authorities and any property held by those authorities for the purpose of, or in connection with, any functions so transferred.

A copy of the draft Order, together with a copy of the Scheme, has been deposited at the Office of the Clerk to the Lincolnshire River Board, 50 Wide Bargate, Boston, Lincs, and at the office of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (Room

410), Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1, for public inspection for a period of twenty-eight days from the date of the publication of this notice and may be inspected during normal office hours.
