The Hampshire (Alton Rural District No. 18) Public Path Diversion Order, 1960

Notice is hereby given that the above Order, made on the 29th day of April 1960, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

SCHEDULE

Existing Routes

Path No. 10. From a point on Road U.229 approximately 67 yards east of Hole House, running south-westwards across field O.S. Parcel No. 179 for a distance of 130 yards to the western boundary of the field.

Path No. 18. From its junction with the above Path No. 10 approximately 67 yards east of Hole House, running south-eastwards across fields O.S. Parcels Nos. 179, 181 and 186, crossing a footbridge over a ditch, to its junction with another path at the south-western corner of field O.S. Parcel No. 188, a distance of 560 yards.

Path No. 17. From a point on the Alton-Farnham Road A.31, approximately 150 yards south-east of Welche's House, running north-eastwards across fields O.S. Parcels Nos. 184 and 185 to its junction with the above Path No. 18 at the south-western corner of field O.S. Parcel No. 188, a distance of 290 yards. (Hants Sheet XXVIII. 10, 1910 Edition.)

New Routes

Path No. 10. From a point opposite Hole House on the Alton-Farnham Road A.31, running southwards along the western boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 179 for a distance of 90 yards to its junction with the existing path.

Path No. 18. From a point on Road U.229 north-east of Broadhatch Lodge, running south-eastwards along the eastern boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 186 to a point opposite a footbridge over a ditch, a distance of 465 yards.

Path No. 17. From its junction with the existing path at a point on the Alton-Farnham Road A.31, south-east of Welche's House, running north-westwards along the western boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 184 to the north-western corner of

the field, thence north-eastwards along the northern boundaries of fields O.S. Parcels Nos. 184 and 185, crossing a footbridge over a ditch to its junction with the above Path No. 18 at the eastern boundary of the latter field, thence southwards for 43 yards along the said eastern boundary to the existing path, a total distance of 390 yards. Existing Route

From a point on the farm road leading to Bentley Green Farm, at the north-eastern corner of O.S. Parcel No. 272, immediately south-west of the Farm, running south-westwards along the northern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 272 for approximately 250 yards, thence southwards for 80 yards along the western boundary of the Parcel and in a general south-westerly direction along the southern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 23, across former site of part of Coldrey Copse to a point approximately 75 yards from the south-western corner of the remainder of the Copse, a total distance of 665 yards.
