

*Town and Country Planning Act, 1947**Marple, Ches*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 and section 111 (4) of the above Act amending the Stopping Up of Highways (County of Chester) (No. 7) Order, 1959, which authorises the stopping up of a footpath at Marple Hall, Marple, Cheshire, and requires the provision of a new footpath, by substituting for the new highway a new footpath on a route different from that specified in that Order.
