Trent River Board

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, as applied by the River Boards Act, 1948, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Trent River Board for the transfer to the River Board of all such property, rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities as are vested in or to be discharged by the Birmingham Corporation over or in connection with those parts of the

Rivers Tame and Cole within the city of Birmingham as are "main river" of the Trent River Board.
A copy of the draft Order, together with a copy of the Scheme, has been deposited at the offices of the Town Clerk of Birmingham, The Council House, Birmingham 1, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, (Room 410), Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1, for public inspection for a period of twenty-eight days from the date of the publication of this notice and may be inspected during normal office hours.
