

ANGLESEY COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Anglesey (High Street, Cemaes Bay) Traffic Regulation Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Anglesey County Council propose to make an Order under Section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 the effect of which will be to revoke "The County of Anglesey (Cemaes Bay) (No. 3) Traffic Regulation Order, 1959" (which imposed unilateral restrictions on the waiting of vehicles in the length of road specified hereunder between 10 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day during the period from 15th June to 15th September in any year) and to substitute therefor the following restrictions, that is to say: To prohibit during the period commencing on the 1st May and ending on the 30th September in each year (save for boarding, alighting from, loading or unloading, waiting in connection with building operations, road works and mainlaying) the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in the said length of road on the sides thereof specified hereunder and to restrict the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in every hour on the side of the said length of road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting.

ANGLESEY COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Anglesey (Beach Road, Benllech) Traffic Regulation Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Anglesey County Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to revoke "The County of Anglesey (Benllech) Traffic Regulation Order, 1962" (which prohibited the waiting of vehicles for 24 hours a day (including Sundays) in the lengths of road specified hereunder from 15th June to 15th September in each year) and to substitute therefor the following restrictions, that is to say: To prohibit, during the period commencing on the 1st May and ending on the 30th September in each year (save for boarding, alighting from, loading or unloading, waiting in connection with funerals, building operations, road works and main laying and for taking in petrol from any garage) the waiting of any vehicle for 24 hours a day (including Sundays) in the said lengths of road:

Lengths of Road at Benllech in the County of Anglesey

1. B.5108—from a point 50 yards south of the Sea Shell Cafe to a point 125 yards north-west of Sea Shell Cafe.
2. Unclassified Road—from the termination of Road B.5108 at a point 50 yards south of Sea Shell Cafe, along the promenade to a point approximately 150 yards west of Wendon Cafe.

ANGLESEY COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Anglesey (Cemaes Bridge) (Load Restriction) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Anglesey County Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle, the weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds eleven tons on so much of the County Highway (A.5025) at Bridge Street, Cemaes in the County of Anglesey as is carried by the Cemaes Bridge over the River Wygyr.

Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit
