

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

1. *The County of Cornwall (Truro) (One Way) Order, 1963.*
2. *The County of Cornwall (King Street and St. Nicholas Street, Truro) (Prohibition of Right-Hand Turn) Order, 1963.*

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to make Orders under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

1. to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to that length in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on King Street, Truro so as to make a right-hand turn into St. Nicholas Street, Truro.

Objections to these proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 26th March 1963.

A copy of each of the proposed Orders, together with a plan showing the lengths of road referred to in the Orders will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at the County Hall, Truro.

(ii) Quay Street (A.39)—between its junction with Princes Street and its junction with Boscawen Bridge and Town Quay	North-west to South-east
(iii) Town Quay (Unclassified City Road)—between its junction with Boscawen Bridge and Quay Street and its junction with Back Quay.	North-west to South-east
(iv) Back Quay (Unclassified City Road)—between its junction with Town Quay and its junction with Green Street.	East to West
(v) Back Quay (Unclassified City Road)—between its junction with Green Street and its junction with Lemon Street.	East to West
(vi) Lemon Street (A.39)—between its junction with Back Quay and its junction with Boscawen Street.	South to North
(vii) Boscawen Street (A.39)—between its junction with Lemon Street and its junction with Princes Street and Duke Street.	West to East
(viii) Little Castle Street (Unclassified City Road)—between its junction with Kenwyn Street and its junction with River Street.	South to North

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Fowey) (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles during the period from the 1st June to the 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year

- (a) throughout the whole of each day in the length of road specified in the First Schedule hereto; and
- (b) from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily during the said period in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to allow a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable vehicles to be used in connection with building operations, the maintenance or improvement of the lengths of road or of the services therein; to take in petrol, oil, water or air from a garage and in connection with a funeral.

Objections to this proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 26th March 1963.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan showing the lengths of road referred to in the Order, will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at the County Hall, Truro, and at the Borough Offices, Fowey.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Length of Road in the Borough of Fowey

- (i) The Penellick—Polkerris Harbour Road (Unclassified Borough Road)—from its south-westerly extremity at the entrance to Polkerris Harbour for a distance of 260 yards in a north-easterly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Borough of Fowey

- (i) St. Fimbarrus Road (Unclassified Borough Road)—from its junction with Daglands Road for a distance of 66 yards in a south-westerly direction.

- (ii) Tower Park Road (Unclassified Borough Road)—southern side—from a point 210 yards south-west of its junction with Daglands Road for a distance of 150 yards or thereabouts in a south-westerly direction.

- (iii) The Fowey—Lostwithiel Road (B.3269)—from Fowey Railway Station for a distance of 210 yards in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Rawlings Lane.

- (iv) Place Road (Unclassified Borough Road)—between its junction with Lostwithiel Street and its junction with Passage Lane.

- (v) Readymoney Road (Unclassified Borough Road)—from its junction with Tower Park Road for a distance of 155 yards in a south-westerly direction to Point Neptune House.
