

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Somerset (North Street and Silver Street, Wiveliscombe) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963.

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd day of February 1963, the County Council of Somerset made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit subject to the following exceptions the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive on the lengths of road described in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exceptions

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from a vehicle; to enable a vehicle to wait in connection with any funeral, building operations road works and services; and to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage.

The Order will come into operation on the 4th March 1963.

*Lengths of road upon which waiting is prohibited
Parish of Wiveliscombe*

(a) North Street (Class 3)

From its junction with the Trunk Road A.361 at The Square to a point 140 yards north west of that junction (both sides).

(b) Silver Street (unclassified road)

From its junction with the Trunk road A.361 at The Square and High Street to a point 100 yards north east of that junction (both sides).
