The Hampshire (Romsey and Stockbridge Rural District No. 10) (Parish of Michelmersh, Footpath No. 2) Public Path Extinguishment Order, 1961.

Notice is hereby given that the above Order, made on the 6th day of November 1961, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to extinguish the public right of way in the Parish of Michelmersh commencing at a point on the Southampton-Stockbridge Road A.3057 at Timsbury, approximately 110 yards south of its junction with Road U.98, running north-westwards across O.S. Parcels Nos. 175 and 174 to the north-western corner of the latter Parcel, a distance of 245 yards. (Hants Sheet XLVIII. 11 and 12, 1942 Edition).

The footpath referred to in the Order is Path No. 2 in the Parish of Michelmersh, as shown on the

Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way prepared under the provisions of Part IV of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.

Existing Route

Commencing at a point on a farm track opposite the old School at Timsbury, running north-westwards for 76 yards along the track, thence northwards across O.S. Parcel No. 289 to its northern boundary and north-eastwards to the north-eastern corner of the Parcel, approximately 117 yards south-east of Manor Farm, a distance of 244 yards.

Commencing at a point on the drive leading to Derrydown Farm, approximately 200 yards south of the Wherwell-Hurstbourne Tarrant Road B.3048, at the north-eastern corner of O.S. Parcel No. 741, running in a north-westerly direction along the northern boundaries of the said Parcel and the site of former allotment gardens (O.S. Parcel No. 742), to the north-western corner of the latter Parcel at the south-eastern corner of the Recreation Ground, a total distance of 316 yards.

New Route

Commencing at a point on the drive leading to Derrydown Farm, approximately 104 yards south of the Wherwell-Hurstbourne Tarrant Road B.3048, at the eastern boundary of O.S. Parcel No. 743, running in a north-north-westerly direction across the said Parcel to the south-western corner of the Parcel, at the south-eastern corner of the Recreation Ground, a total distance of 273 yards.
