#### DRAFT SPECIAL REGULATIONS FACTORIES ACT 1961

In pursuance of section 180 of, and the Fourth Schedule to, the Factories Act 1961, the Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that he purposes to make Regulations to substitute for the definition of "appointed doctor" in the Pottery (Health and Welfare) Special Regulations 1950 and in the Mule Spinning (Health) Special Regulations 1953 a new definition by virtue of which the appointed factory doctor for the district is to be the appointed doctor for the purposes of those regulations for a factory in his
