EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

1. This Order amends the Order of the 11th June 1920, the Order of the 9th March 1921 and the Order of the 29th September 1949, as amended by subsequent Orders.

2. The normal maximum rate of the allowances for constant attendance is increased from £104 a year to £130 a year in the case of officers and from 40s. a week to 50s. a week in the case of ratings and the maximum rate for exceptional cases of very severe disablement is increased from 80s. a week to 100s. a week in the case of officers, nurses and ratings. (Articles 2, 7, 10 and 14.)

3. The pension rates for certain widows of officers and ratings are increased by £37 a year and by 14s. a week respectively. (Articles 3, 12 and 18.)

4. The allowances payable to widows in respect of children are increased from £83 10s. or £77 10s. a year to £96 10s. or £90 10s. a year in the case of children of officers and from 29s. a week to 34s. a week in the case of children of ratings. (Articles 4, 8, 15 and 25.)

5.—(1) The rates of pensions and allowances payable to or in respect of the children of deceased members of the naval forces (such children having become motherless or having ceased to be under the control of their mother) are increased from £128 10s., £100 or £120 10s. a year to £149 10s., £116, or £141 10s. a year in the case of children of officers and from 34s. 6d. or 46s. a week to 40s. 6d. or 54s. a week (according to the age of the child) in the case of children of ratings. (Articles 24 and 25.)

(2) The rates of pensions payable to motherless children who, having attained the age of 18 years,

are incapable of self-support by reason of infirmity which arose before they attained the normal age limit for pension purposes, are increased from £149 10s. a year to £175 10s. a year in the case of children of officers and from 57s. 6d. a week to 67s. 6d. a week in the case of children of ratings. (Articles 5, 9, 16, 24 and 25.)

6.—(1) The rates of pensions for 100 per cent. disablement are increased by £46 a year in the case of officers and nurses and by 17s. 6d. a week in the case of ratings with proportionate increases for lower degrees of disablement. (Articles 6, 11, 13, 17 and 23.)

(2) The maximum rates of the "Addition to Service Retired Pay" payable to certain disabled officers and nurses are increased from £290 a year to £336 a year in the case of officers and from £265 a year to £311 a year in the case of nurses. (Articles 11 and 13.)

7. The allowance for unemployable pensioners is increased from £164 a year to £193 a year in the case of officers and from 63s. a week to 74s. a week in the case of ratings. (Article 19.)

8.—(1) The total additional allowance payable in respect of the wife or adult dependant of an unemployable pensioner and of a pensioner receiving approved treatment is increased from £91 a year to £108 a year in the case of officers and from 35s. a week to 41s. 6d. a week in the case of ratings. (Articles 19, 21 and 22.)

(2) The allowances payable in respect of children of unemployable pensioners or of pensioners receiving approved treatment are increased in respect of the first or only child from £45 10s. a year to £52 a year in the case of officers and from 17s. 6d. a week to 20s. a week in the case of ratings and in respect of
