

WALLASEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The County Borough of Wallasey (Various Streets)
(Restriction on Waiting) Order No. 1, 1963*

Notice is hereby given that the Wallasey County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to restrict the permissible period of waiting of vehicles in parts of the following streets in the Borough:

Groveland Road; Liscard Crescent; Marine Promenade and Wellington Road.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from such vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from such vehicle, to enable such vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road and the services therein, and to enable such vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the specified lengths of road.

WALSALL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Walsall (Upper Rushall Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963
