

SOUTHEND-ON-SEA COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

County Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Streets adjoining Parking Meter Area) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th February 1963 the Council of the County Borough of Southend-on-Sea made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to:

- (a) prohibit waiting 24 hours daily in parts of London Road, Queens Road, Gordon Place, Hamlet Road, Ashburnham Road, Princes Street, Park Street, Park Road, Southchurch Road, Grange Gardens, Whitegate Road, Prittlewell Street, Essex Street, Warrior Square East, Porters Grange Avenue, Bankside, Quebec Avenue, Portland Avenue, York Road, Heygate Avenue, Chancellor Road, Corsham Road, Darnley Road, Herbert Grove, Lucy Road, Scrutton Road, Nelson Street, Warrior Square and Capel Terrace;
- (b) prohibit waiting from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily in parts of Gordon Place, Scrutton Road and Capel Terrace;
- (c) provide for monthly unilateral waiting in parts of Ashburnham Road, Princes Street, Park Street, Queens Road, Quebec Avenue and Portland Avenue;
- (d) provide for 30 minute waiting in any one hour in a part of Southchurch Road.

(A) The Borough of Rugby (Moultrie Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963

(B) The Borough of Rugby (Park Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Rugby Borough Council propose to make the above Orders under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (subject to the usual exemptions) between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. on the stated sections of the following streets:

Order (A). Street Moultrie Road. Section Both sides from its junction with Clifton Road for a distance of 50 yards in a southerly direction.

Order (B). Street Park Road. Section Both sides from its junction with Newbold Road in a northerly direction to a point 20 yards north of its junction with Regent Place.

WEST BRIDGFORD URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The West Bridgford (Hound and Fox Road Street Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963.

The West Bridgford (Central Avenue and adjacent Roads) Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1963.

The West Bridgford (Bridgford Road Parking Place) Order, 1963.

Notice is hereby given that the West Bridgford Urban District Council propose to make Orders under subsection (1) of section 81, and subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960; subsection (2) of section 11 and subsection (1) of section 16 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

(a) By the West Bridgford (Hound and Fox Road Street Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963:

(1) To authorise the use as a parking place for the classes of vehicles specified in the Order of part of the North West side of Hound Road and part of the West side of Fox Road in position specified therein, on each week-day from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.,

the maximum period for which vehicles may wait being 8 hours, and

(2) To prohibit the waiting of any vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the whole lengths of the South Eastern side of Hound Road and the Eastern side of Fox Road respectively except as provided in the Order.

(b) By the West Bridgford (Central Avenue and adjacent Roads) Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963:

(1) To authorise the use as Parking Places for the classes of vehicles specified in the Order of parts of Rectory Road—South side, Albert Road—North side and Gordon Square, in positions specified therein, on each week-day from 8 a.m. to 12 (midnight), the maximum period for which vehicles may wait being Two hours.

(2) To authorise the use as Parking Places for the classes of vehicles specified in the Order of parts of Gordon Road (West side) and Central Avenue (West side), in positions specified therein, on each week-day from 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. the maximum period for which vehicles may wait being 30 minutes.

(3) To prohibit the waiting of any vehicle on parts of Gordon Road (East and West sides), Davies Road (North and South sides), Albert Road (North and South sides), Tudor Square, (except the part adjacent to Nos. 19 to 22 (inclusive)), Central Avenue (East and West sides), and Bridgford Road (East and West and South-East and North-West sides) on each week-day between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. except as provided in the Order.

(c) By the West Bridgford (Bridgford Road Parking Place) Order, 1963:

(1) To authorise the use of the Parking Place provided by the Council having a frontage to and means of entrance to and egress therefrom on Bridgford Road on each day on which the parking place is superintended by an authorised uniformed attendant by the classes of vehicles specified in the Order subject to the positions, charges and maximum periods of waiting specified therein, and

(2) To authorise the use of the Parking Place on each day other than the aforesaid days by the classes of vehicles specified in the Order subject to the positions and maximum periods of waiting specified therein.

Each Order also makes provision for the Disposal of Vehicles abandoned on Parking Places.

Copies of the draft Orders may be inspected at the Council Offices, The Hall, Bridgford Road, West Bridgford, during the usual office hours, or may be obtained on application to the undersigned.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 1st day of April 1963.

KINGSTON UPON HULL CITY AND COUNTY COUNCIL

The Kingston upon Hull (Wheeler Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963
