Notice is hereby given that on the 27th February 1963 the Dorset County Council made an Order under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on various lengths of road in the Urban District of Swanage as follows:

 Waiting prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. daily throughout the year, on
 (a) Stafford Road—between its junction with High Street and a point 57 yards south of that junction;
 (b) Waldron Road—on its southern side between its junction with De Moulham Road and its junction with Shore Road.

Waiting prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. during the period between 1st May and 30th

September inclusive in any year, on
De Moulham Road—on its western side between its junction with the northern side of Victoria Avenue and a point 38 yards north of its junction with the northern side of Gannets Park.

The Order, which will come into force on the 1st April, 1963, contains exceptions to enable vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for persons to board or alight, for goods to be loaded or unloaded, for use connection with any building or demolition work, for the removal of any obstruction to traffic or in connection with any works on any public services in or near the lengths of road.

(xi) Both sides of Calverley Park Gardens for distances of 45 feet from its junction with Calverley Road.

(xii) Both sides of Lansdowne Road for distances of 45 feet from its junction with Calverley Road. (xiii) Both sides of Mountfield Road for distances of 45 feet from the junction with Grove Hill Road.

(xiv) The north western side of that length of Hanover Road lying between its junction with Mount Ephraim Road and a point 75 feet north

east of that junction.

(xv) The southern side of that length of Mount Ephraim Road lying between a point 70 feet east of its junction with the Inner London Road and a point 185 feet east of the same junction.

(xvi) The northern side of that length of Mount Ephraim Road lying between a point 45 feet east of its junction with Rock Villa Road and a point 113 feet east of the same junction.
