FIRST SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Gover Lane (Unclassified District Road) (a) from its junction with Beachfield Avenue for a distance of 15 yards in a southerly direction; (b) from its junction with Bank Street for a distance of 15 yards in a northerly direction; (c) west side—between a point 15 yards south of its junction with Beachfield Avenue and a point 15 yards north of its junction with Bank Street.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Tolcarne Road (Unclassified District Road)—from its junction with Cliff Road for a distance of 15 yards in a south-easterly direction;
 (ii) Beacon Road (Unclassified District Road)—between its junction with Red Lion Square and its junction with Headland Road;
 (iii) Tower Road (B.3282) (a) from its junction with Sydney Road for a distance of 15 yards in a south-westerly direction; (b) from its junction with Crantock Street for a distance of 15 yards in a north-easterly direction;
 (iv) Higher Tower Road (B.3282) (a) from its junction with Mount Wise for a distance of 43 yards in a northerly direction; (b) from its junction with Crantock Street for a distance of 15 yards in a southerly direction;
 (v) Ullahia Road (Unclassified District Road)—(a) from its junction with Narrowcliff for a distance of 15 yards in a south-easterly direction; (b) western side—between its junction with Edgcombe Avenue and a point 15 yards south-east of its junction with Narrowcliff;
 (vi) Hilgrove Road (Unclassified District Road) (a) from its junction with Narrowcliff for a distance of 15 yards in a south-easterly direction; (b) western side—between a point 15 yards south-east of its junction with Narrowcliff and its junction with St. Annes Road;
 (vii) The Crescent (Unclassified District Road) (a) from its junction with Bank Street for a distance of 45 yards in a northerly direction; (b) north-eastern side—between a point 45 yards north of its junction with Bank Street and a point 167 yards north-west of that junction;
 (viii) Mount Wise (B.3282) north side—between its junction with Higher Tower Road and a point 15 yards east of that junction;
 (ix) Pentire Road (Unclassified District Road)—north side—between its junction with Higher Tower Road and a point 15 yards west of its junction with Atlantic Road.

EIGHTH SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Tolcarne Road (Unclassified District Road)—between a point 15 yards south of its junction with Cliff Road and its junction with Albany Road.
 (ii) Higher Tower Road (B.3282)—between a point 43 yards north of its junction with Mount Wise and a point 15 yards south of its junction with Crantock Street.

The County of Cornwall (Godolphin Road, Long Rock) (One-Way) Order 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle other than in the direction from south to north on the length of Godolphin Road, Long Rock in the parish of Ludgvan between its junction with the Hayle—Penzance Road (A.30) and its junction with the connecting road

THIRD SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Grosvenor Avenue (Unclassified District Road) (a) from its junction with East Street for a distance of 15 yards in a southerly direction; (b) east side—between a point 15 yards south of its junction with East Street and a point 80 yards south of that junction.

FOURTH SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Trevemper Road (A.3075) western side—between a point 150 yards north-east of its junction with Gannel Road and a point 150 yards south-east of that junction.

FIFTH SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Edgcombe Avenue (A.3075) (a) from its junction with Cliff Road for a distance of 15 yards in a south-easterly direction; (b) north-east side—from a point 15 yards south-east of its junction with Cliff Road for a distance of 35 yards in a south-easterly direction.
 (ii) East Street (A.392) (a) between its junction with Marcus Hill and a point 15 yards east of its junction with Grosvenor Avenue; (b) from its junction with Berry Road for a distance of 15 yards in a westerly direction.

SIXTH SCHEDULE

Lengths of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Mitchell Avenue (Unclassified District Road)—between its junction with Seymour Avenue and its junction with Mount Wise;
 (ii) Marcus Hill (Class III)—(a) from its junction with East Street to a point 15 yards south of its junction with Seymour Avenue; (b) from its junction with Mount Wise for a distance of 15 yards in a northerly direction; (c) west side—between a point 15 yards south of its junction with Seymour Avenue and a point 15 yards north of its junction with Mount Wise.
 (iii) St. Michaels Road (Unclassified District Road)—from its junction with Marcus Hill for a distance of 75 yards in a westerly direction;
 (iv) St. Mary's Road East (Unclassified District Road)—from its junction with St. George's Road for a distance of 140 yards in an easterly direction;
 (v) Crantock Street (Class III)—northern side— from its junction with St. George's Road for a distance of 50 yards in a westerly direction.

Length of Road in the Urban District of Newquay

- (i) Gover Lane (Unclassified District Road)—eastern side—between a point 15 yards south of its junction with Beachfield Avenue and a point 15 yards north of its junction with Bank Street.
