The Trunk Road (Hyde Road, Woodley) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1963

On the 28th March 1963, the Minister of Transport made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Act 1960 which will come into operation on the 18th April 1963.

The effect of the Order is that with certain exceptions, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday:

- (i) in either of the lengths of the Liverpool-Warrington-Stockport-Sheffield-Lincoln-Skegness Trunk Road (A.560) specified in Schedule 1 hereto;
- (ii) in that length of the said trunk road specified in the first column of Schedule 2 hereto:
 - (a) on the side of the road specified opposite that length of road in the second column on even dates; or
 - (b) on the side of the road specified opposite that length of road in the third column on odd dates; or
 - (c) on the side of that length of road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting by sub-paragraph (a) or (b) above.
 - (i) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
 - (ii) if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side.
