The QUEEN has been graciously pleased on the advice of Her Majesty's Australian Ministers, to approve the award of the George Medal to the undermentioned:

Lieutenant John Cecil RHODES (35853) R.A.A.M.C. attached 3rd Battalion Royal Australian Regiment:

On the 19th February, 1962, Lieutenant Rhodes was passing a house when a shot was fired through the door killing a Police Constable. He hastened to the assistance of the fallen policeman and then saw a rifle fired from a side window. Soon afterwards when ordered by Police Sergeant S. A. Walker to drop his weapon, the man in the house again fired through the window. Sergeant Walker returned the fire and the man, evidently wounded, moved away from the window. Lieutenant Rhodes who had remained by the side of the stricken Constable, then approached the front door with Sergeant Walker and, in spite of the fact that two more shots were fired through it kicked the door in. In spite of a further shot through the open door an entry was effected and the demented man was overpowered.
